RESOLUTION

Authorizing and directing the Committee on the Judiciary to investigate whether sufficient grounds exist for the impeachment of Donald John Trump, President of the United States.

1	Resc	olved, That the Committee on the Judiciary, acting as	
2	a whole o	or by any subcommittee thereof appointed by the	
3	chairman for the purposes hereof and in accordance with the		
4	rules of t	the committee, is authorized and directed to	
5	investigate fully and completely whether sufficient grounds		
6	exist for the House of Representatives to exercise its		
7	constitutional power to impeach Donald John Trump,		
8	President of the United States of America, including but not		
9	limited to:		
10	(1)	obstruction of justice;	
11	(2)	violations of the Foreign Emoluments Clause and	
12	Don	nestic Emoluments Clause of the United States	
13	Con	stitution;	
14	(3)	conspiring with others to:	
15		(a) commit crimes against the United States	
16		involving the solicitation and intended receipt by the	

1		Donald J. Trump campaign of things of value from a
2		foreign government and other foreign nationals; and
3		(b) conceal those violations;
4	(4)	advocating illegal violence, giving aid and comfort to
5	whi	te supremacists and neo-Nazis, and
6	und	ermining constitutional protections of equal protection
7	under the law;	
8	(5)	abusing the pardon power; and
9	(6)	recklessly threatening nuclear war against foreign
10	nati	ons, undermining and subverting the essential
11	dipl	omatic functions and authority of federal agencies,
12	incl	uding the United States Department of State, and
13	enga	aging in other conduct that grossly and wantonly
14	end	angers the peace and security of the United States, its
15	peoj	ole and people of other nations, by heightening the
16	risk	of hostilities involving weapons of mass destruction,
17	with	reckless disregard for the risk of death and grievous
18	bodi	ily harm.
19	SEC	. 2. (a) For the purpose of making such investigation,
20	the comm	nittee is authorized to require—
21		(1) by subpoena or otherwise—
22		(A) the attendance and testimony of any person

1	(including at a taking of a deposition by counsel for
2	the committee); and
3	(B) the production of such things; and
4	(2) by interrogatory, the furnishing of such
5	information;
6	as it deems necessary to such investigation.
7	(b) Such authority of the committee may be exercised—
8	(1) by the chairman and the ranking minority
9	member acting jointly, or, if either declines to act, by the
10	other acting alone, except that in the event either so
11	declines, either shall have the right to refer to the
12	committee for decision the question whether such
13	authority shall be so exercised and the committee shall be
14	convened promptly to render that decision; or
15	(2) by the committee acting as a whole or by
16	subcommittee.
17	Subpoenas and interrogatories so authorized may be issued
18	over the signature of the chairman, or ranking minority
19	member, or any member designated by either of them, and
20	may be served by any person designated by the chairman, or
21	ranking minority member, or any member designated by either
22	of them. The chairman, or ranking minority member, or any

- 1 member designated by either of them (or, with respect to any
- 2 deposition, answer to interrogatory, or affidavit, any person
- 3 authorized by law to administer oaths) may administer oaths
- 4 to any witness. For the purposes of this section, "things"
- 5 includes, without limitation, books, records, correspondence,
- 6 logs, journals, memorandums, papers, documents, writings,
- 7 drawings, graphs, charts, photographs, reproductions,
- 8 recordings, tapes, transcripts, printouts, data compilations
- 9 from which information can be obtained (translated if
- 10 necessary, through detection devices into reasonably usable
- 11 form), tangible objects, and other things of any kind.
- SEC. 3. There shall be paid out of the applicable accounts
- of the House such sums as may be necessary to assist the
- 14 Committee on the Judiciary in conducting the inquiry under
- 15 this resolution, any of which may be used for the procurement
- 16 of staff or consultant services.
